Prone Rifle National Classifications are awarded to individuals who have previously competed at an NSRA National Rifle Meeting (Scotland/Bisley). Normally, an individual who, in the previous two years, has not entered an NSRA National Meeting or entered but did not fire all the targets in an Aggregate will be deemed an 'Unclassified Competitor'. However, there not being any NSRA National Rifle Meetings since 2019 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, an individual's National Classification as of the end of 2019 will remain valid for 2022.

Unclassified Prone Competitors, those without a valid National Classification, must substantiate their class by submitting the average of the best 10 of their last 12 scores on British NSRA 1989 short range targets (ex. 100) or 50 metres/yards targets (ex. 600").
