We are recruiting a **Light Weight Sporting Rifle Secretary** to facilitate the running of these Leagues and a **Benchrest** Secretary to do the same.

Bisley 100 dates are 13 August to 20th August 2022.

The Bisley Special Events are a match shot on 1922 style targets, a rapid fire match shot at 50 metres and the Aggregate Champion of Champions match, open to all past Weekend or Championship Aggregates winners. Scores from the Weekend, Week aggregates, 1st stage of the Roberts, the 1922 match and the 50m Rapid fire match will create "**The Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Championship**".

Geoff Doe has come out of retirement to manage Bisley 100. He has asked for help with a few preparation jobs. Chris Ingram and 3 others from Essex will be travelling down to Bisley to assist on the Century range which will be closed for de-leading by the NRA. If anyone is free **Monday 9**th **May** and can help please contact Chris Ingram.

In addition volunteers are required to help setup, run & pack-up Bisley 100. Please contact Geoff Doe or NSRA Competitions if you can help. Thank You.

Our patron **HM Queen Elizabeth II** has written to the NSRA giving her warmest wishes for the event, the letter will be published in the Special Commemorative booklet that will be found in the Bisley 100 welcome envelope.

The **Essex Tent** will be available at Bisley where we can keep sheltered and enjoy tea, coffee & biscuits with the odd bit of banter!

Essex shooters & supporters will be wearing purple this Bisley to help mark the Queens Jubilee event. We are having special purple commemorative Polo Shirts produced replacing the word "Shooting Team" with "Bisley 100" adding the words "Platinum Jubilee" below the shooters/supporters name. Orders will be available at the Essex County Championships, cost of £15 each.

Shoulder to shoulder County meetings are a staple of the calendar and we in Essex do enjoy competing against our neighbouring Counties.

Essex recently defended the **Six Counties Trophy** by winning at the Doug *Mottram Range* in Cambridgeshire, with a score of 4,509 which tied with Cambridgeshire, we won on count-back using the 100yd aggregate as the decider.

The conditions were windy to say the least, everyone considered themselves having a poor shoot but we somehow managed to outshoot the rest *(just)!* Scores: Essex 4,509, Cambridgeshire 4,509, Norfolk 4,473, Bedfordshire 4,478, Suffolk 4,355 and Hertfordshire unable to field a team.

Next on the agenda is the **Marks Shield**, due to be hosted by Kent at *Tunbridge Wells R*&*PC* on Sunday 22nd May 2022.

The Inter County Postal's have finished, Essex A in Division 2 4th. Essex C in Division 9 1st winning all 10 rounds. Vets team 3 in Division 3 1st. Top scorers were Chris Ingram (10), Dan Lake (11) & Geoff Webb (12).

The **Greville League** was concluded a few months back.

Division 1 was hotly contested by both **Romford A** & **Colchester A** both on 18 points each with *Romford A* achieving victory with a better gun score by 20 points winning the **Greville Cup**.

Top scorer was *Geoff Webb* 993, an average of 99.3, winning the *Brickles Trophy*. Div 2 winners were Basildon B 3,805.

The **National Service Leagues** are almost finalised, Division 1 results are in with **Romford A** and **Colchester A** again tied on 18 points, both losing a round to each other once with *Romford A* wining on gun score 23 points ahead. Top scorer was *Chris Ingram* 994, an average of 99.4.

The **Essex Individual** Competition results will be out soon. Stage 1, 3 cards at 25yds and stage 2 also 3 cards at 25yds, the winner will win the coveted **Essex Green Medal** only available once per year. *All the above mentioned Essex competitions are shot at 25yds.*
