

10 Metres Individual Air Pistol & Air Rifle leagues. Summer 2025

Competition Notes & conditions

- 1. Targets to be used, 10 metre, Air Rifle 3/89-18, Air Pistol 4/89-18
- 2. Each round will consist of 20 shots, 5 shots per card at each set of four cards, each shooter should sign his or her cards immediately they have been shot and ensure that the targets are witnessed and dated by a club official. Each round must be completed within two hours.
- 3. The competition will run in divisions of 6 shooters per division. Where there are less than 6 shooters in a division, a bogey shooter will be assigned with the same entered average of the opponent shooter.
- 4. Averages need not be submitted for competitors shooting in current Essex air leagues. All other averages to be calculated from any current recognized league. These and Club averages accepted on the basis of any competitors whose average during the competition unreasonably exceeds their entered average may have their average re-evaluated and handicap applied as appropriate.
- 5. Clubs will have the options of sending shot cards to scorers or self-scoring, if self-scoring one member of the club to be appointed as scorer.
- 6. If only one member of club entering then shot cards must be posted to scorer.
- 7. All cards must be kept to end of league in case scorer / organiser decides to check cards.
- 8. The organiser has the right to request any cards, whether random shooters or all the club cards, to be forwarded to him, either by photo or posted as deemed appropriate. Certain round/s will/may be requested for checking to ensure competition accuracy & fairness.
- 9. Targets must be received by the scorer by the Saturday following the last day for shooting. Targets arriving after that date will be disqualified.
- 10. Scorers to email the organiser the results of the rounds asap.
- 11. Extensions to match periods will be granted only if applied for before the expiry of match period.
- 12. Any problems which cannot be resolved by the scorer will be dealt with by the organiser, whose decision will be final.
- 13. Results will be sent via email. If required by post, please enclose a Stamped Addressed Envelope/s.
- 14. Ties will follow the NSRA rule 5.5.3 relating it to both teams & Individuals.
- 15. The winner and runner up of each division will receive an Essex County Air Medal.
- 16. Proposed Round last day for shooting dates will be:
