COURSE OF FIRE: Double Dewar (40 shots at 50 metres, 40 shots at 100 yards)

THE CHAMPIONSHIP CUP

The **Hackney Ensign Cup** and **Special County Medal** will be awarded to the competitor with the highest aggregate and who resides within the county.

LADIES, VETERANS AND JUNIORS

A County Medal will be awarded to the Lady, Veteran and Junior with the highest score in the aggregate who resides within the county.

ACCESS

Single Dewar handicap (based on second Dewar cards) using the declared average on the entry form.

PAIRS

The **Bernie Allsop & Norman Garner Tankards** will be awarded to each winning pair from their class banding. Pairs will be decided from entrants in A&B Class combined and C&D class combined. Each entrant can be guaranteed at least one entry into the pairs competitions, pairs will be selected at random by a committee member and all pairs will be decided before the start of the competition.

PRIZES & DISTRIBUTION

Medal's for 1st and 2nd in each class. Prize presentation will take place in the range club-house after the close of shooting and stats completion on the day.

CONDUCT OF SHOOTING

NSRA Rules for open meetings will apply, so see that your equipment complies, if you are in any doubt, please ask. You may be required to use clips for your backer targets. Shooting is under the control of the Committee and the range will have a RO on duty at all times. Breech flags are to be inserted or action removed at all times whilst not shouldered.

STATS OFFICERS

All scoring will be carried out by officials the Committee appoints. Challenges are allowed at **£2.00** each.

The Range Committee reserves the right to re-classify competitors as necessary on the day.

RANGE OFFICERS

Range Officers who shall be responsible for the safe conduct of shooting and range discipline will be appointed by the Committee.

PRACTICE No practice shooting will be allowed other than normal sighting shots.

REFRESHMENTS will be on sale in the club house.
